

MARM 2007 CHEMAGINATION CONTEST



“Chemagination” is a contest in which High School students are asked to *imagine* that they are living 25 years in the future and have been invited to write an article for [ChemMatters](#), a magazine for high school students that focuses on the role of chemistry in everyday life. The subject of the article is: “*Describe a recent breakthrough or innovation in chemistry and/or its applications that has improved the quality of people’s lives today.*” The article is written to fit in one of four categories (either Alternative Energy Sources, Environment, Medicine/Health, or New Materials.)

In addition to the article, students are asked to design a cover for the magazine. The article must be written as if the student is living in the year 2032, looking back at innovations that have occurred since 2007.

The Regional Chemagination Competition will take place on Saturday, May 19, 2007 at Ursinus College, Collegeville, PA 19426. The time and meeting room have not yet been determined.
